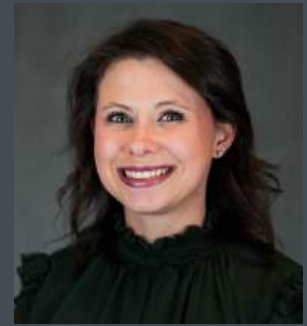

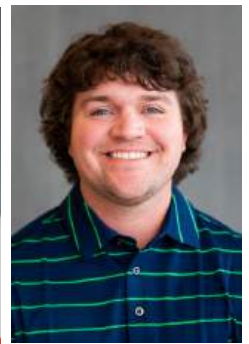

NEVADA SCHOOL DISTRICT



On July 1, 1987, five small school districts in southern Nevada County consolidated to establish the Nevada School District. The district is located in a safe, rural area in the small community of Rosston, AR. NSD serves students in grades K-12 on one campus.

NSD's mission is to provide a safe school climate in which all students are permitted to reach their highest educational goals.

Educators are committed to creating a supportive and academically challenging learning environment that helps students

see their potential for success. Educators attend rigorous and innovative training programs to ensure the most effective instructional practices.

The district provides a variety of educational opportunities. A Career Action Planning Program is in place for students in grades 7-12 to help students and their parents explore educational and occupational possibilities and make appropriate career decisions based on a solid base of information. Educators work with all students and their parents in developing and maintaining individualized student success plans. Students are offered a variety of electives including business courses, agricultural courses, and coding classes. Students are given the opportunity to enroll in advanced placement courses and/or concurrent credit courses through Virtual Arkansas or at the local community college to begin preparing for post-

secondary education while earning high school and college credit. Students also have the opportunity to enroll in one of four areas of study at UAHT's Secondary Career & Technical Education Center. The Secondary Career Center provides students with hands-on experiences in a variety of career fields.

The district also offers a variety of extra-curricular activities for those students maintaining the required GPA. Students in grades 7-12 may participate in basketball, track, volleyball, trap shooting, cheerleading, and band, as well as a host of school based clubs. Students have the opportunity to serve the community while obtaining community service hours and a community service learning credit through the district's award winning FBLA program and through the National Honor Society. Students in grades 9-12 can participate in golf, baseball, and softball.

Nevada School District offers a Pre-K program to ensure that our students are ready for school.

Nevada School District offers a student/teacher ratio of 11:1, allowing significantly more one on one instructional time for students. Students and educators have access to the latest technology to support our students' college and career readiness including one virtual lab and Chromebooks or iPads and Promethean Boards in every classroom.

CITY OF PRESCOTT, ARKANSAS

Prescott is strategically located between Memphis and Dallas along Interstate 30 in a predominately rural area of Southwest Arkansas. Prescott is a community of 3101. Prescott offers a mild, four season climate. The average high is 77 degrees, with an average low of 54 degrees. Over the course of a year, Prescott typically receives 55.37 inches of precipitation. The rural nature of the community brings many quality of life advantages to families. The school district is smaller allowing for more hands-on time with children. The low crime rate in the community is attractive to many who want to raise their families without the fear often associated with living in a larger community. Several neighborhoods have adopted crime watch areas. The sense of community and the ability to be involved in all aspects of the community's life is appealing to many people.

Even though Prescott and Nevada County are rural, we are a short drive from many larger communities. Just 45 miles from Texarkana, which has many shopping, dining, and entertainment options.

The attractions offered at Hot Springs, a popular convention and vacation area, are only an hour and five minutes away. Little Rock is located 90 miles up Interstate 30 and hosts a wide range of social activities including theatre, dinner theatre, concerts, and sporting events.

For those who like a more natural form of recreation, the area boasts five state parks within a 45-mile radius of Prescott. Hunting, fishing, and boating opportunities abound in the area. Many

people travel from other countries and states to enjoy the camping and fishing opportunities found at White Oak Lake State Park located in Nevada County. Prescott has all the conveniences of a large community. From internet accessibility to pet grooming to automotive repair and restoration. Services are provided by local merchants who quickly know your name and preferences. Likewise, the community is continually striving to improve the quality of life in the area. The City of Prescott and Nevada County have a new \$1,000,000 library and recent efforts have resulted in the restoration of the old Missouri Pacific Railroad Depot (which houses the Nevada County Museum) and the refurbishment of all the sidewalks downtown.

Prescott is home to three primary care clinics that serve the population of 3,101. Each of the primary care clinics also have specialist who come into their clinics on periodic basis. Our Pafford Medical Services offers a quick response time for local residents and businesses. The community is served by Wadley Regional Medical Center of Hope. The transport time by ambulance is 13 minutes.

Prescott has regional access to a large number of educational institutions. The University of Arkansas Community College at Hope (15 miles) provides many job training activities for area businesses, including courses for Holcim (Formally Firestone Building Products) located in Prescott.

Cossatot Technical College Extension Center in Nashville (35 miles) offers customized training opportunities for

area industries on a regular basis. SAU Tech is a technical two-year college that is located in East Camden (50 miles) and specializes in training for defense and aerospace industries.

Three four-year universities are located within 30 miles of Prescott. Henderson State University and Ouachita Baptist University offer a wide range of four-year degree programs and are located in Arkadelphia (30 miles by I-30). Southern Arkansas University is located in Magnolia (30 miles) and offers several liberal arts programs as well as industry specific classes.

Just a little further away in Texarkana (45 miles via I-30) is Texarkana College, which has a number of technical classes offered as part of the standard curriculum and Texas A&M University-Texarkana offers our leaders of tomorrow with a high quality, rewarding, and affordable education experience.

Prescott's employers draw workers from a 12 County population base of 227,143. The community's central location and access to post-secondary education and training options add to the availability of the area's workforce. The labor shed offers diverse skill sets and employment opportunities, with the largest sector being manufacturing. Approximately 22 percent of the region's workforce is employed in manufacturing, with services and retail also well represented. The Prescott workforce is prepared and eager to meet its existing and future employers' labor needs.

THE HISTORY AND IMPACT OF THE PRESCOTT/NEVADA COUNTY LIBRARY

The Prescott/Nevada County Library and Educational Facility was completed in June 2003 under the leadership of Mayor Howard Taylor and County Judge James Roy Brown. The facility's design was crafted by Jerry Hollensworth of Trull-Hollensworth in Magnolia, Arkansas, while Doyle Howard of Doyle Howard Construction, Inc. in Delight, Arkansas, served as the contractor.

In 1999, a significant milestone was achieved when a one-million-dollar grant was secured by State Senator Mike Ross for the construction of a new facility. This effort was supported by additional legislators, including State Representatives Sandra Rodgers and Tommy Roebuck and Senator Percy Malone.

A generous \$75,000 challenge for furnishing the new facility was issued by Mrs. Jane Bemis, who pledged to match up to \$75,000 raised for the endeavor. The citizens of Nevada County, along with supporters across Arkansas and the United States, rose to the occasion, raising the additional \$75,000. Ms. Jayne Randolph, Prescott Elementary School Media Specialist, played a pivotal role as planner and coordinator of furnishings, working alongside Mrs. Bemis, Mrs. Gibson, and the Friends of the Library. Services and Offerings

Libraries hold immense value for their communities, and the Prescott/Nevada County Library is no exception. The library

provides access to essential resources such as internet services, Wi-Fi, genealogy tools, books, audiobooks, e-magazines, and hotspot lending. Additionally, patrons can enjoy online services from the comfort of their homes, including e-books, access to the card catalog, and the Traveler Database. New services include hotspot lending and remote printing, which expand accessibility for patrons both on-site and at home. The library also offers free income tax assistance services (VITA) and is actively working on providing digital literacy classes to further support the community. The library's summer reading programs are a highlight, offering engaging books, detailed information on various themes, and special guests and performances. Furthermore, the library served as a distribution location for the Arkansas No Kid Hungry feeding program, supporting children both during the summer and after school.

The facility's spacious meeting room is a hub for community activities, hosting events such as GED classes, senior fitness sessions, financial planning workshops, job counseling, and kids' cooking and coding classes.

CHILDREN'S AREA AND LITERACY PROGRAM

The children's area has evolved into a comfortable and engaging space for young readers to explore books and technology. With tablets for interactive learning and fun furniture to encourage reading, the space fosters a love for literacy and learning. Librarian Theresa Tyree recently secured a \$1,000 grant to further enhance children's literacy programs.

TECHNOLOGY AND UPGRADES

While library services remain free to the public, ongoing funding efforts are crucial for major purchases and technological updates.

In 2019, a generous \$20,000 donation was made by Kitty Sloan in memory of her uncle, John Teeter, co-founder of the Nevada County Depot and Museum. John Teeter filled his life with serving this community. These advancements require patrons to use library cards to access computers, simplifying the process and enhancing efficiency. The new system also supports seamless printing, faxing, and scanning services. Payments for these services can now be made conveniently at the library kiosk using cash, coins, credit/debit cards, or Apple/Google Pay. The new technology also lays the foundation for additional future services, ensuring a modern and streamlined library experience for all patrons.

HISTORICAL LOCATIONS AND LEADERSHIP

Nevada County Library has a rich history, with its original location in an old school building (gym) at the site of the current Daniel's Trailer Park (West Elm/West Second/West Third). Subsequent locations included East Second Street across from the courthouse, 123 West Main, and the corner of West Second South and West Elm. The current library, located at 121 West Main in downtown Prescott, continues to serve as a cornerstone of the community. The library's legacy is also reflected in

its leadership. Former librarians include Mrs. King, Mrs. Bess Giest, Mrs. Lois McCain, Mrs. Lanora Dalrymple, Mrs. Judy Westmoreland-Hart, Mrs. Helen Miller, Mrs. Joyce Gibson, and Terri Vandiver. Today, the library is led by Mrs. Theresa L. Tyree, whose dedication ensures that the Prescott/Nevada County Library remains a vibrant resource for the community.

PRESCOTT COUNTRY CLUB

Built in 1969 and designed by architect Al Rayford, the Prescott Country Club is located just two miles from downtown Prescott at 1667 US Highway 67 North. The Country Club features a nine-par, 36-length, 3,182-yard golf course as well as a driving range for practice. With the region's moderate weather year-round, the course remains open for 12 months and serves as the host venue for the Prescott High School golfing team as well as numerous regional and local golf tournaments and scrambles annually.

The facility also includes a clubhouse with a dining area and a swimming pool, which traditionally opens at the start of May. Each year, the Country Club hosts the Nevada County Cancer Association Tournament and the Business and Industry Appreciation Dinner and Golf Tournament. Additionally, the Men's and Women's Golf Associations at the club sponsor many golf tournaments and scrambles throughout the year.

PRESCOTT RACEWAY

Prescott Raceway is located at 5121 Highway 53 E, Prescott, Arkansas, and is owned and operated by Jackie and Velvet Lewis. Built in 1975, the 1/8th-mile track has been under their ownership since 2010.

Races are held about 36 weeks a year, weather permitting. Racers travel from across the United States, including Minnesota, Missouri, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Texas, and Arkansas. The track offers various racing classes, such as Super Pro, No Box, Jr. Dragsters, Index, Sportsman, and beginner races. Concession stands are available for spectators.

WHITE OAK LAKE STATE PARK

White Oak Lake State Park is an official Arkansas State Park located two miles from Bluff City, 21 miles from Prescott, and 22 miles from Rosston. Situated at the Nevada County and Ouachita County line, the park offers camping and RV facilities, boat and bike rentals, playgrounds, and swimming areas.

White Oak Lake, spanning 1,656 acres, is the second-largest lake created by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. Established in 1961, the lake is surrounded by rich woodlands and miles of pine trees. The lake, known for its submerged and dormant trees, is a popular spot for outdoor enthusiasts and fishermen, with an abundance of bass, crappie, bream, and catfish.

The park also features hiking trails with frequent sightings of deer and other wildlife. Bird watchers often visit to catch a glimpse of American bald eagles. Located off Arkansas State Highways 387 and 24, the park attracts residents and tourists from the southwest Arkansas region.

Nearby, Poison Springs Battleground State Park, a well-known Civil War battlefield, is just eight miles southeast in Ouachita County. For more information, contact White Oak Lake State Park at 870-685-2748.



PRESCOTT SPLASH PAD

The Prescott City Park Splash Pad opened in June 2018 as a successful completion of a multi-year economic development project. Operating six days a week (Monday-Saturday) from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sundays from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m., the Splash Pad is free to the public during the summer months.

The Splash Pad operates on automated water cycles running in ten-minute increments. Users press a designated restart button to activate the water sprays again. Prescott Mayor Terry Oliver noted that approximately 70% of the water outlets spray at a given time, ensuring water conservation while maintaining fun.

Economic Development Director Mary Godwin highlighted the Splash Pad's importance, saying, "It has been a long time coming, and this fits in the category of 'Quality of Life.'" She emphasized its role in attracting and retaining businesses by offering family-friendly attractions.

The Splash Pad features a special slip-proof concrete surface to prevent accidents. Additional seating and park enhancements complement the attraction.

PRESCOTT-NEVADA COUNTY PRARIE D'ANE BATTLEFIELD

Prairie D'Ane Battlefield, Elkins Ferry Battlefield, and the rear action at Moscow (April 4–13, 1864) became sacred ground with the loss of life of American soldiers in both Blue and Grey uniforms.

The Red River Campaign was designed by Union forces to halt the cotton trade in Texas. General Frederick Steele was tasked with bringing Federal troops (US) south from Little Rock. His command consisted of 13,000 men, 20,000 draft animals, and over 800 wagons. General Nathaniel Banks was to advance north from Louisiana up the Red River to combine forces near Shreveport, then proceed west into Texas through the Red River Valley.

By April 12, 1864, General Steele had reached Prairie D'Ane but realized he could not sustain his men and animals by foraging. He decided to change plans. Rumors suggested that Camden had supplies, so Steele redirected his forces toward Camden with the hope of resupplying and retreating toward Little Rock. This campaign would later be titled "The Camden Expedition" by General Steele and historians.

Around April 4, there were only 1,500 Confederate (CSA) soldiers to delay Union forces from crossing the Little Missouri River at Elkins Ferry. Fighting

ensued as the Confederates retreated to the area now known as the Nubbin Hill Community. (A historical marker is located at Missionary Grove Baptist Church.) General Sterling Price, commanding CSA troops, had amassed between 3,500–5,000 soldiers in the area. Price feared the Federals would attack the City of Washington, which was the Confederate capital of Arkansas at the time (Little Rock was under Federal occupation). Believing Washington was the Union target, General Price ordered fortifications on Prairie D'Ane and prepared for General Steele's advance. Skirmishes with infantry, cavalry, and artillery battles occurred from April 8–12, with the heaviest fighting on April 11 and 12.

The Union forces gave the impression of an attack by using artillery and cavalry, while

secretly moving most of their wagons and troops toward Camden. (A historical marker about the Battle of Prairie D'Ane is located in front of the TA Truck Stop).

On April 13 and 14, approximately 2,000 fresh Confederate troops arrived from Indian Territory to support the CSA. Realizing the Union advance toward Camden was a diversion, General Price ordered an attack on the Union rear columns on April 13. The Confederates engaged the Union forces near the site of the Potlatch buildings, moving through parts of southeast Prescott toward the village of Moscow. (A historical marker at Moscow Cemetery further describes the rear action and battle in the Moscow area).

Battlefield tours can be scheduled for groups by appointment.





NEVADA COUNTY DEPOT & MUSEUM



Prescott was established in 1873 when the Cairo & Fulton Railroad platted the city and sold lots along the company's planned route through Arkansas. From that point on, Prescott's development was closely linked to the rise of rail travel. Companies such as the Missouri Pacific (now Union Pacific) and the Prescott & Northwestern Railroads had a significant influence on the development of the region, contributing to a population boom that lasted well into the 20th century. By the 1940s, automobiles had replaced rail as the primary means of travel for most. The development of the Bankhead Highway (now Highway 67) had a huge impact on the city, making the conveniently located Prescott a travel hub. Today, freight trains are still a common sight, and Highway 67, along with the newer Interstate 30, brings thousands of travelers through Nevada County on a daily basis.

The Nevada County Depot Museum preserves and shares this rich history through exhibitions and public programs. Located in the historic 1912 Missouri Pacific Depot building, the museum's displays feature the story of Prescott, Nevada County, and Southwest Arkansas, from the Caddo occupation of the area through World War II. The Depot Museum offers permanent exhibits on several topics, including exhibits honoring Prescott's own Governor Thomas McRae and artifacts found at the historic Prairie D'Ane Battlefield. The museum also hosts speakers and traveling exhibits throughout the year.

The Depot Museum is a 501(c)(3) private nonprofit humanities organization dedicated to sharing and preserving the history of Prescott and Nevada County, Arkansas. The museum is open for free, self-guided tours Thursdays through Saturdays, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Visitors can request a free tour of the historic 1920 Prescott & Northwestern Railroad caboose situated adjacent to the depot building. Travelers can stop by for refreshments and information on other historic sites and markers to visit in Nevada County and the surrounding area.

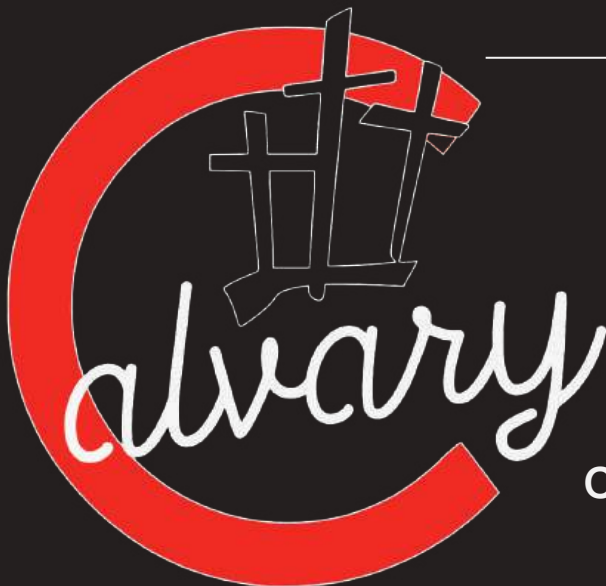
