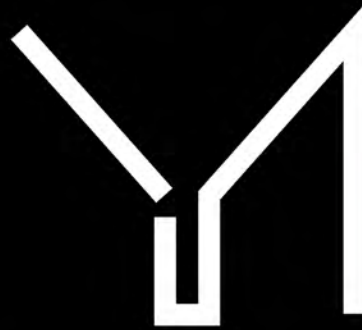

THE PACK IS BACK AND HUNGRY FOR A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Prescott Curley Wolves Coach Brian Glass is very excited about the upcoming 2023 season as this pack of Curley Wolves are deeper than ever. Coach Glass raves about the speed, strength, and how hungry this group of young men are to reach the goal of bringing home a State Championship to Prescott. The Curley Wolves fans can expect a hard-hitting defense that is going to fly to the football. An offense with tons of speed and skill is looking to put up crazy numbers this season. I spoke to Pierce Yates this past week and he described this offense using one word, "Explosive." With an O-Line that is collectively a couple hundred pounds heavier than last season, the offensive front looks to bully the competition this season. Rocco Loe said this about the O-Line this season, "The most improved part of the line is the depth. They are bigger and stronger."

Coach Glass broke down the season into three separate parts, with part one being non-conference, which consists of traveling to Bismarck to open the year, crossing state lines into Oklahoma for a showdown

with 5-A State Runner-up McAlester, and then traveling to Hope for a matchup with the Bobcats. They will host Fordyce and Homer this season to round out the non-conference part of the schedule. Glass is excited about the non-conference games as it will give their defense different looks to defend against, which will only help them throughout the year.

Part two of the season is conference play, and looking to bring home yet another conference championship, the Curley Wolves will have to withstand conference road games against Junction City, Fouke, and Smackover. Prescott will play host to Gurdon and Horatio. In a district where Smackover is always very good, Junction City and Gurdon are always tough and have great programs, and with Fouke and Horatio improving every year, Coach Glass is looking forward to the challenge.

The final part of the season will be the playoff run, a deep playoff run that, hopefully, ends up with the Curley Wolves raising the State Championship Trophy. The confidence, speed, depth, and intensity of this pack

of Curley Wolves are going to be a handful. The only thing more dangerous than a pack of Curley Wolves, is a hungry pack of Curley Wolves, and this group is starving for the State Championship.

QUARTERBACKS

Pierce Yates will conduct the offense for the Curley Wolves this season, and Yates is looking forward to distributing the ball around and using all the weapons he is blessed to have surrounding him. Coach Glass started off the QB conversation with, "Pierce is the quarterback that looks better in real football than in 7 on 7, and he is a good, physical runner." Yates dropped his 40-time down to a 4.8 this summer and is looking stronger and more comfortable in the pocket. Expect nothing but stellar play from Yates this season.

RUNNING BACKS

You might not find a deeper RB group in the state of Arkansas in 3A football, as Prescott is very talented in the backfield. Senior Ja'Noah Harris has blazing speed and hits the hole hard, and any time he touches the ball

there is a chance he can take it to the house. KJ Page, Sophomore RB, will also get a lot of carries. Tiquan Box could see action from the RB spot and the slot as well. Addyx Williams will also see action out of the backfield and is very skilled. Coach Glass is really excited about the talent he has lining up in the backfield. Colton Arnold will line up at FB some this season with Rocco Patrick also lining up at FB a few times this season.

WIDE RECEIVERS

Jaylen Johnson is definitely a weapon for the Curley Wolves, as he is the fastest athlete on the field and stands at 6'3" and 200lbs. Dwayne White, 6'4" and 185, is very elusive and a handful to bring down to the ground. P.J. Gulley in the slot will be a chore for opposing teams to try and keep up with. Spencer Hubbard has been very impressive over the summer as he displayed great hands and ball skills with elite route running. When the QB Pierce Yates used the word "explosive," this WR group is what he was talking about, playmakers for days and they should find the endzone quite often this season.

OFFENSIVE LINE

This O-line will set the tone for the offense, and Coach Glass marveled at the O-line saying, "This group is light years ahead of last season at this time." You have Rocco Loe at Center, and RG Joey Pittman, LG Jaden Carter, RT Rocco Patrick, and LT Tanner Jarvis are going to be a handful. Also, Gavin York, Luther Williams, and Latavion

Lofton, who can play any position on the line, brings a lot of depth to the offensive line this upcoming season. Lineman Rocco Patrick was asked about the expectations for this season, Patrick said "Expectations never change. Win every game, and win state." This group of young men plan on dictating the line of scrimmage this season.

DEFENSIVE LINE

The front 4, Fantastic 4, or any other terminology used to describe perhaps the best defensive line around, will have QBs running for their lives all season and limiting the opposing running game. Jamarion Burton is a monster up front, Marshawn Rafter on the other end will cause offensive tackles and opposing QBs to have nightmares all season long. Rocco Patrick and Rasheed Muhammed will clog the middle. This line is going to make opposing offensive coordinators' lives very difficult in game-planning against Prescott. Jamrion Burton spoke about the strengths of this loaded defense saying, "Best D-Line in the state!"

LINEBACKERS

Returning LB Talan Smith had around 140 tackles last season for the Curley Wolves and has been voted as one of the best LBs in the state. Coach Glass talked about Talan's work ethic and expects big things from him this season. Tayshawn Smith will also be a presence this season at OLB for the Curley Wolves, while LB K.J. Page, sophomore, will continue to grow. The coaching staff

sees a lot of ability in this young man. Jayden Purtle will also see a lot of reps at LB this season.

SECONDARY

This group at the back end of the defense reminds one of a mixture of the "No Fly Zone" from the Denver Broncos and the "Legion of Boom" from the Seahawks a handful of years ago. They have ballhawks all over the secondary, speed, and a group that Coach Glass says loves contact. With that unique mixture of speed, coverage ability, and hard-hitting mentality, this secondary could be a very special group. With Richard Benton and Jayquan Dickerson at CB, PJ Gulley is going to be all over the place. Decari Prater is moving to safety with the injury of JK Jones, who is hopefully due back really soon, and Prater is definitely a playmaker. Lavonte Gleason was very impressive this summer and the coaches speak wonders of his ability. Prater had this to say on the topic, "This secondary is very good, deep, and will be very hard to score against this season." Do not be surprised if you see more forced turnovers than opposing passing TDs this season.

I spoke to Glass as well about new additions to the coaching staff and is excited about the addition of Brandon Walker, ex-Curley Wolve player who will coach the secondary/WRs. Khalid Stuart will be over the RBs and LBs, Quinten Thorton is new OL Coach, Coach Jason Patrick is the Assistant Coach/Defensive Coordinator,

Coach Taylor Wood will coach the Defensive Line and be Co-Defensive Coordinator, and Davion Williams is really excited about the season as he is the Offensive Coordinator. Tim Loe is the Asst. Offensive and Defensive Line Coach, Gavin McCauley is Special Teams Coordinator, Tony Price is an Assistant Coach, and Jeremy Glass is Asst. Line coach and coaches the Jr. Team as well. They are all looking forward to the season. The Curley Wolves will open their season traveling to Bismarck on August 25th. Prescott has a great chance to do some very special things this season; they are loaded with talent, speed, great coaches, and they are very hungry for a championship.

JR. CURLEY WOLVES

The Curley Wolves Junior Football Team is gearing up for another season and the goal is simple: an undefeated conference championship and for all 38 players to play sound team football. There are a lot of guys returning from last season on the defensive side of the ball, including three defensive linemen: Ja'ryan Zachary and Alex Munoz, very fast and physical at the DE positions, and Jamarion Yates who will clog up the middle. Hunter Williams and Justin Fricks will see a lot of reps this season on the D-Line as well. Brian Woodley tore his ACL this off-season or else that would be another force that opposing teams would have to reckon with. Mario Brownlee returns at LB for the Jr. Curley Wolves and will

be the most physical player on the field night in and night out. Kayden Gleason, Rodquez McKinney, Angel Esparaza, and Curtis Stockton will also help out at LB this season. Keymon Benton is returning in the secondary this season, and Benton had a huge pick six to end the half against Junction City last year. At safety, Owen Glass will be the voice of the secondary. Deonte Huddleston, Trayvion Evans, and Rhett Cornish will also bring great ball skills and speed to the secondary.

On the offensive side of the ball there are a lot of fresh faces lining up for Prescott. Rhett Cornish had a good bit of action as QB last season and will get the nod to run the offense this season. The offense goes as he goes, and Cornish has great speed and an excellent arm. Mario Brownlee and Kayden Gleason will be the 1A and 1B options at RB. Brownlee is the more physical of the backs, with Gleason being the speedster. This off-season, Cornish and WR Owen Glass developed great chemistry and the two should connect often this upcoming season. Braylon Jefferson, Rodquez McKinney, Wes Cornelius, Talyn Helmick, and Keymon Benton will also be options at the receiver position. The O-Line is going to dictate the game up front, led by Center Brodyn Richardson, Will Avery, Blaine Mckamie, Justin Fricks, and Julian Stafford. Bringing the boom out of the fullback position will be Alex Munoz. The coaches this season are very excited about this group and believe a conference title is very

attainable. Head Coach is Russell Carter and Assistant Coaches are Gavan McCauley, Taylor Wood, Jeremy Glass, Khaalid Stewert, and Chuck Lowery. This is going to be a very exciting group to watch this season, and the Prescott faithful have a lot to look forward to.

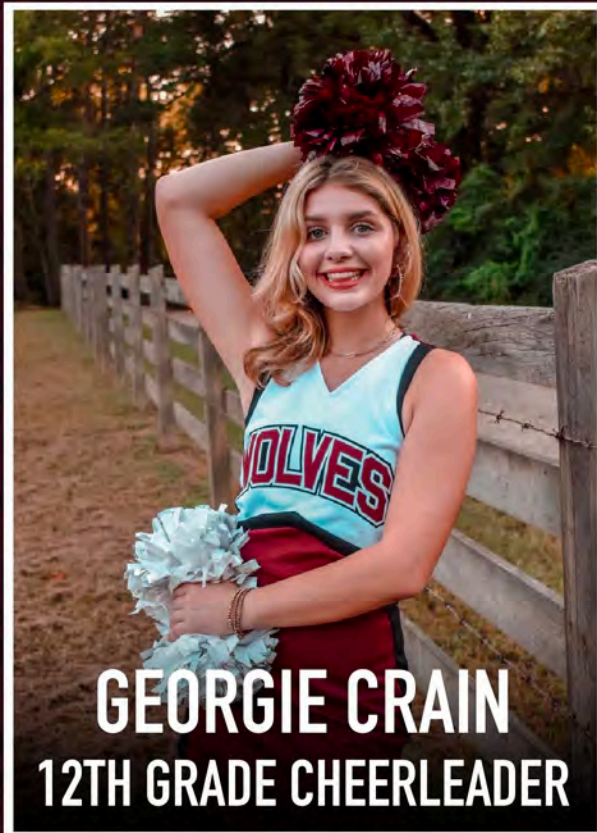

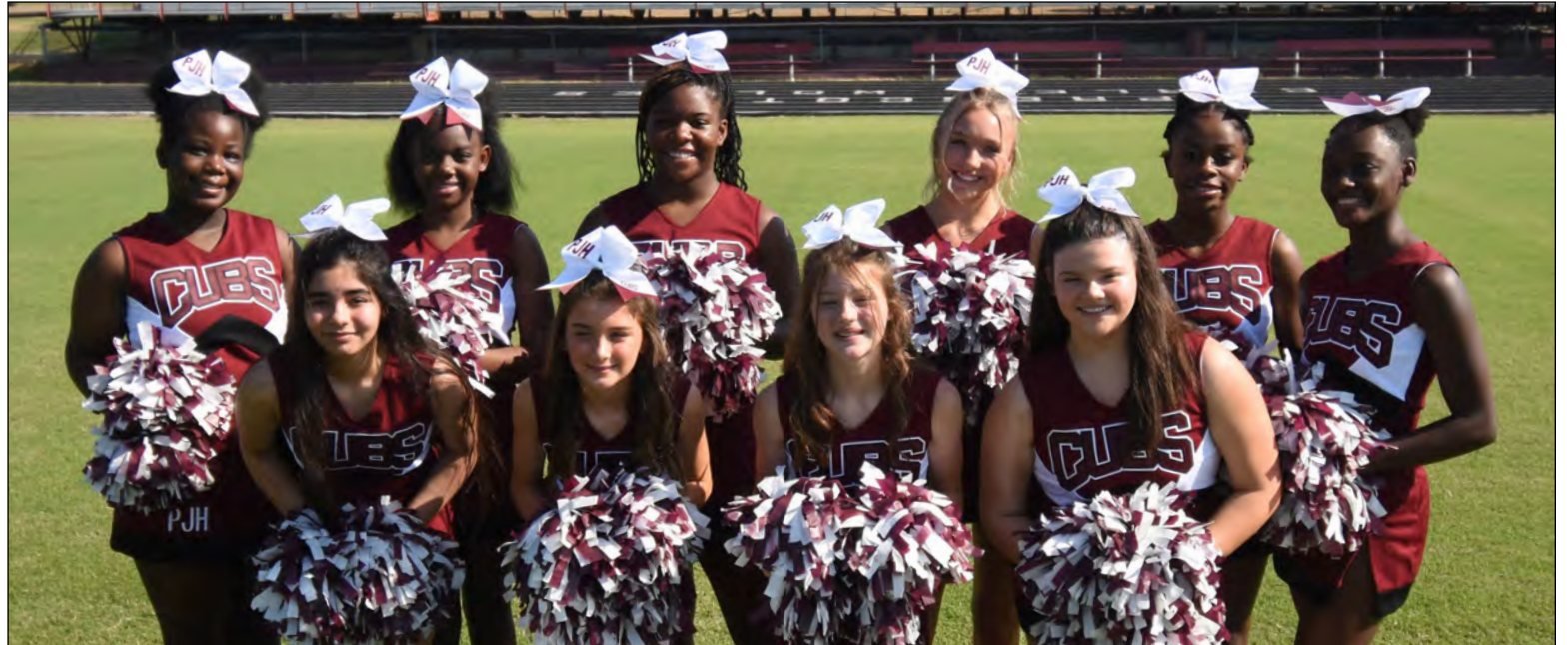

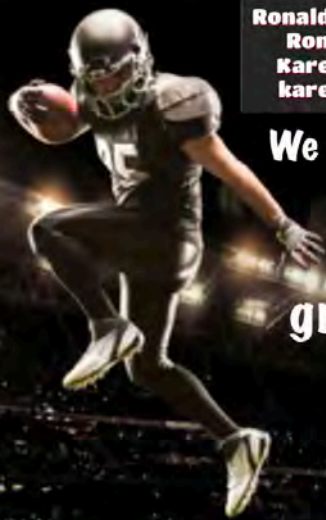
